Energize! Risk Management With Your Enterprise Risk Management Committee!



There is a new name for the Health and Safety/Risk Management Conference offered each summer at Philmont Training Center. It is the Enterprise Risk Management Conference. **The 2014 conference is August 3–9.** Whether you have an active and “seasoned” committee or you are trying to revitalize it, the Enterprise Risk Management Conference has something for everyone. The conference is facilitated by members of Risk Management and Health and Safety national staff as well as a Scout executive and representative from the National Health and Safety Support Committee. Even with the facilitators, conference attendees interact, work in teams, and share “war stories.” There is a core set of topics, but conference attendees are highly encouraged to bring topics that affect their Scouts, Scouters, and council.

This hands-on conference is designed to give attendees the tools and information they need to ensure the physical and mental well-being of participants in the Scouting program, lead efforts to instill the values of personal fitness; to manage accident, injury, and illness prevention, and to protect the people, property, and environment of the Boy Scouts of America. Participants learn:

- The leading causes of incidents and conduct exercises in hazard and risk identification, analysis, and resolutions using the latest in program hazard analysis techniques.
- Conduct an accident investigation, and analyze it to prevent future occurrences.
- Learn to establish or maintain effective enterprise risk management committees.
- Understand insurance and compliance issues as well as some leading causes of accidents.

Each attendee should take home information for protecting the Scouting program, Scouting’s assets, and most importantly, the people of Scouting.

The conference is open to all members within Scouting, however **scholarships are available for members of the council’s enterprise risk management, risk management, or health and safety committees.** The national Risk Management Department will pay the conference registration fee for the first 25 people who apply and attend this year’s course. They will be reimbursed \$470 after the completion of the course. The offer is available for two people from the council with a Scout executive’s approval. Volunteers are encouraged to bring their professional liaisons.

In addition to offering a positive learning experience in one of the most pristine locations in America, Philmont provides a wonderful program for families of the participants. The family program includes everything that Philmont has to offer in daily activities for spouses and children.
