Where can I serve on staff during the Jamboree?

- Adults who are at least 21 can serve in any Jamboree position for which they are qualified. A young adult who is at least 18 can serve in most positions with the exception of certain shooting, aquatics and other director position that require a person who is 21.
- Most Jamboree areas have positions that can be filled by youth and adults. This includes adventure sports like climbing, skateboarding, and shooting as well as food service, medical, retail, and maintenance/sanitation and many other support and service positions.

Why register as a Jamboree staffer?

- Half price fee (\$425) for staff 16-25 years old when you commit to staff the full Jamboree.
- Participate in Jamboree shows and activities
- Create and develop friendships with Scouts and Scouters across the country and internationally.
