

# Baden-Powell Council Presents

## Distinguished Unit Status for 2011

The Baden-Powell Council is pleased to announce a Distinguished Unit Program that offers financial incentives and breaks to Units that qualify. Benefits extended to Distinguished Units include:

- \$25 Per boy discount on Resident Camp Programs
- Preferential consideration to qualified families in the campership allocation processes (In- Council Units Only)
- Free Year Round Weekend Tent Camping Privileges at any Council Camp.

All qualifications must be met between the end of the previous year's summer camp program and prior to the unit attending camp in the current calendar year. If a unit qualifies after the early bird camp deadlines, late fees for payment still apply; if a unit has paid in full before the early-bird deadline, a rebate check will be issued.

### Qualifications

Baden-Powell Council Units must:

#### **DO ALL 3 (PACKS AND TROOPS)**

1. Be a 2010 Centennial Quality Unit
2. Successfully Participate in the Annual Friends of Scouting Campaign.
3. Successfully Participate in the Fall or Spring Popcorn (or other approved) Council Product Sale.

*(Successful participation will be defined as having conducted the events, and combined, the two events raised more than the units membership on 12/31 of prior year times 50) As example a 20 boy unit will need to have raised \$1,000 combined between items #2 & #3.*

#### **AND (TROOPS ONLY) - DO ONE OF THE FOLLOWING**

4. Participate in one of the Fall or Spring work weekends or events at either camp.
5. As a Unit Conduct a Service Project at one of the Council Camps (generally more than \$500 in documented value) since the end of the prior year summer camp program.

Units from Outside Baden-Powell Council must (**PACKS AND TROOPS**):

1. Be a 2010 Centennial Quality Unit

#### **AND either #2**

2. Refer a Pack or Troop to attend a BPC Resident Camp Program in the upcoming year, and the referred Unit makes a paid reservation.

#### **OR TWO OF THE FOLLOWING** (note the FOS and Product Sale requirements above for in-Council units)

3. Participate in one of the Fall or Spring work weekends or events at either camp.
4. As a Unit Conduct a Service Project at one of the Council Camps that is over \$1,000 in documented value while at summer camp the prior year or before the start of the current summer camp week.
5. Contribute a cash contribution to the Baden-Powell Council of at least \$1,000 within the last 12 months.
6. In addition to a week of summer camp, participate as a unit in one of the 3 day High Adventure Programs offered by the Baden-Powell Council.
