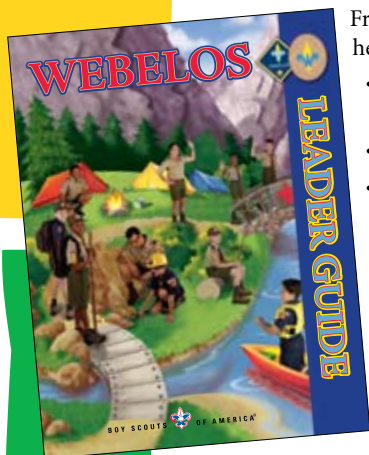
Cub Scout Program Helps, Webelos Leader Guide, and Cub Scout Leader Book: the Foundation for Your Success

- Supportive resources for all leaders



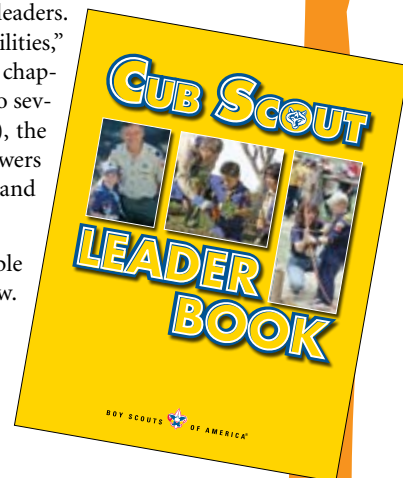
