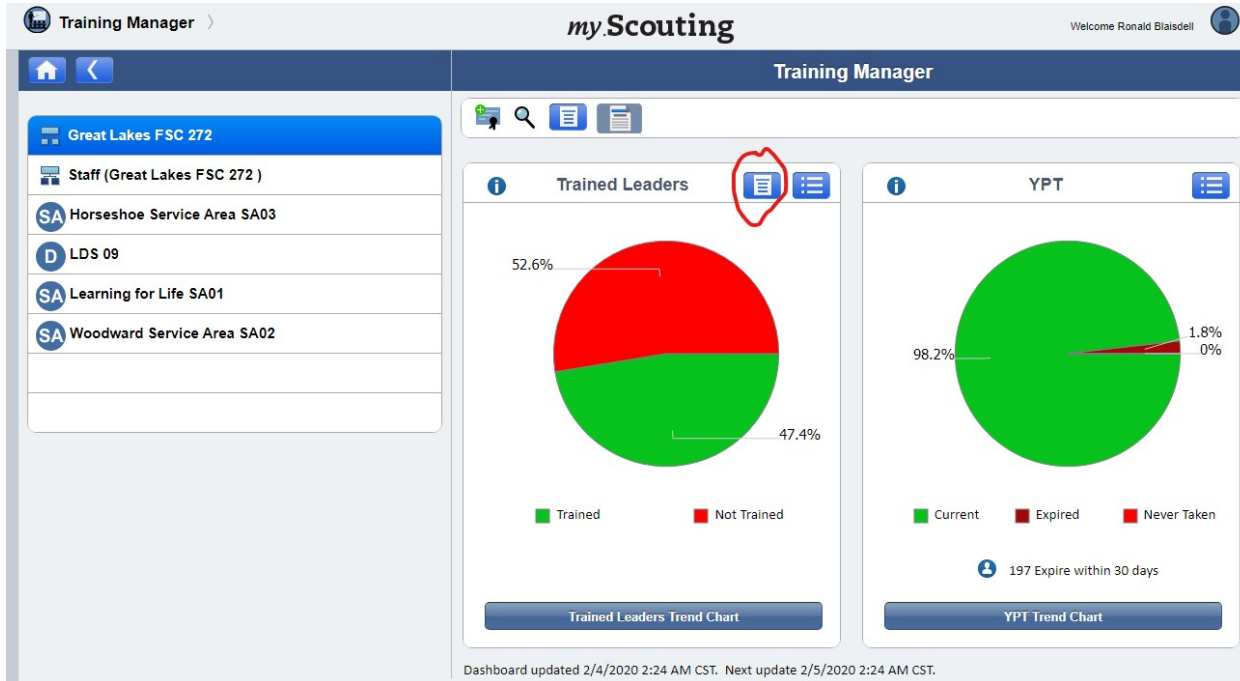


Trained Commissioners PowerPivot Tool

The "Trained Commissioners" PowerPivot tool that will take the Trained Leader reports from Training Manager and provide summary information on the number & percentages of trained and untrained Commissioners by Council & District. This will even allow multiple Council-level reports to be aggregated to provide Area-level summaries.

To use this PowerPivot tool, log into My.Scouting, and in Training Manager, select the Council or District you wish to create the report, and do the following:

Click the report icon (looks like a sheet of paper) immediately above the Trained Percentages pie chart.



Then, once the report runs, you click the "CSV (Details)" button and it will download a report:

As with all our other PowerPivot tables, place your downloaded report(s) in the same subdirectory with the "Trained Commissioners" tool. (Please make sure this subdirectory does not have any other subdirectories beneath it.) Then open the "Trained Commissioners" PowerPivot tool which will do all the necessary calculations.

You can filter the data, across the reports, by using the "Workbook filters" tab. You also have the ability to collapse the data to look at it from a council or district summary level.
