Easy Chocolate Silk Pie for Cub Scouts

Ingredients:

- 1 pre-made pie crust (graham cracker, chocolate cookie or regular pie crust)
- 2 packages instant pudding and pie filling (3.4 to 3.9oz)
- 2³/₄ cup cold 2% milk
- 2 cups whipped cream or 2 cups whipped frozen topping
- optional garnish: chocolate or rainbow sprinkles

Instructions:

- 1. Prepare the pie crust as directed (if baking, cool completely).
- 2. In a large bowl, combine the pudding mix and milk. Whip for two minutes. Pour into the pie shell.
- 3. Refrigerate for two hours.
- 4. Top with whipped cream or whipped topping and sprinkles.
