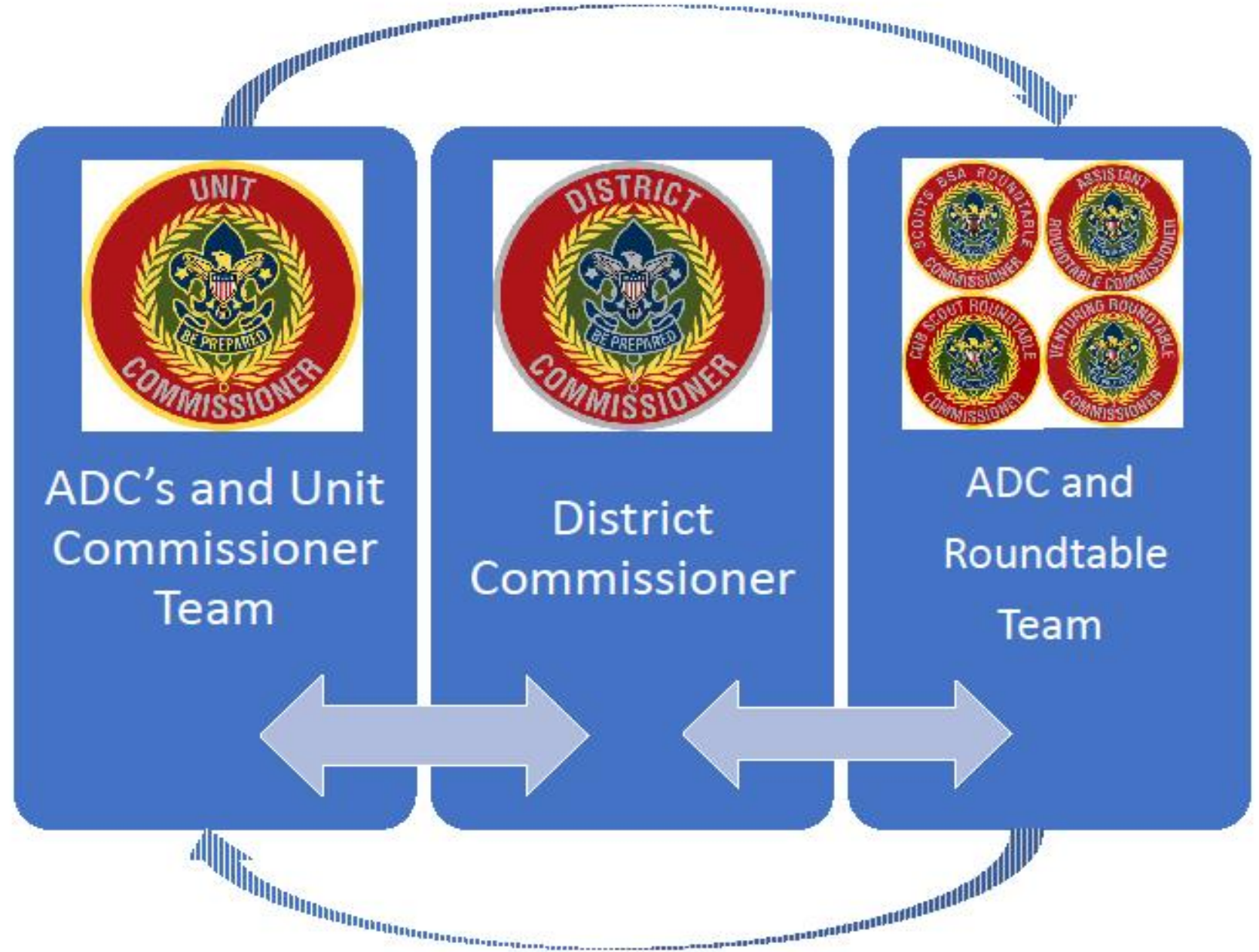

How Technology Can Benefit RT Commissioners

- Identify units not attending
 - Are they units with low health scores or no unit commissioner?
- Identify leader-level attendance
 - Are there opportunities to improve?
- If attendance is low, opportunity for follow-up action
 - Potential council-wide or district RT planning workshop
- Manage RT planning
 - Use Tools for notetaking
- Manage meeting follow-up needs
- Use information to improve unit service



How Technology Can Benefit Admin Commissioners

- Is Attendance meeting expectations?
 - Can we understand why and how to improve?
- If attendance is low, what follow-up is necessary?
- Are the RT planning Tools being used?
- Does planning look sufficient?
- Are there “Teachable Moments” that can help?
- How can unit service be improved?



How Technology Can Benefit Unit Commissioner?

- Which units are not attending?
- Are “my” units not attending and why?
- How many leaders from “my” units are attending?
- How can I encourage my units to attend each month?
- What feedback can I give to the RT commissioner to help?
- How can unit service be improved?
