The New Unit Dashboard

Unit Metrics

Speaking of data, let's talk about **Unit Metrics**. The update introduces six measurable areas that provide insight into your unit data:

- 1. Key Leaders Trained
- 2. Unit Size
- 3. Membership Growth
- 4. Advancement/Youth Leaders
- 5. Outdoor Activities
- 6. Youth Retention

These aren't just random numbers — they provide valuable information about your unit. You and your commissioner can discuss these metrics and look at ways they can offer targeted support, and you both have access to the same data!

Unit Connections

Another big change is something called **Unit Connections**. Instead of commissioners completing "Simple" or "Detailed Assessments," they'll now engage with you in **meaningful, goal-oriented conversations**.

The goal is simple:

- Celebrate your successes.
- Identify challenges.
- Collaborate on solutions.
- Provide resources that actually help.

And to guide these conversations, there's a tool called **Unit Connection Guides** — tailored resources designed to keep the discussion on YOUR goals. That's right! The goals YOU set. No more "grading your unit" — just real support.
