APPLICATION INFORMATION & SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Nomination forms may be submitted annually from the first business day in October through the last business day in January of the following year.

All required nominating materials and supporting documentation for qualified individuals must be submitted in one, collated electronic file with a clear, identifiable name of the nominee for review by the council's selection committee. Please send your nomination submission to the nominee's Council Scout Executive or designee.

There are no restrictions on the number of nominations submitted to the local councils. Even so, a maximum of two Council Duty to God Awards per year may be awarded by 100 and 200 level councils and a maximum of one Council Duty to God Award per year may be awarded by 300, 400, and 500 level councils. Completed nominations will remain on file for two years. If after the second year, the nominee has not been selected, a new application must be submitted for future consideration. Successful nominees should be notified on or before March 1st following close of the 4-month nominating period.
