# Why Scouting America Training?

Trained leaders understand Scouting America's mission, vision, purpose, methods, and values. Trained leaders deliver the promise of scouting to our youth – the promise of adventure, leadership, and growth. A trained leader is knowledgeable and more confident in the role being performed. Trained leaders impact the quality of programs, safety, and a whole lot more. In other words, a trained leader is better prepared to make Scouting all it can be!

### How can I get trained?

Here are four steps to becoming a trained leader.

# 1. Set up a My. Scouting account

Visit My. Scouting and create an account. Once you have an account, you can access online training.

### 2. Complete Safeguarding Youth Training

This is the first training that all leaders must take and is a part of our commitment to keeping our youth safe. Scouting America places the greatest importance on creating the most secure environment possible for our youth members. # 3. Complete Hazardous Weather Training

# 4. Position-Specific Training

Scouting America's Learning Center, at My.Scouting, offers training for all positions for adult leaders in Scouting. Select your position, and a learning plan will be created for you. The plan includes modules that are designed to allow you to complete them at your own pace. To access training after the initial set up, log into My.Scouting and click on My Training from the dropdown menu. From My Training page, click on Requirements to see what trainings are required for your position.
